DESCRIPTION:

Even without formaldehyde, this new formula provides all the power you need. Dis-Spray is still an exceptional preserving and deodorizing embalming spray. And now, it's been enhanced with Mold-X.

Although Dis-Spray has great strength, it can freely be used on even the most delicate tissues including infant cases and the most tender facial areas.

FAST PENETRATING ACTION:

Any embalming spray must come into direct contact with the tissues to be preserved and deodorized. Dis-Spray cuts through surface dirt and body-oil film, because it contains special penetrants. This feature is particularly helpful when a body has died of a disease involving a high fever, since that will cause oily exudates to cover the skin.

APPLICATIONS:

Slowly remove the sheet covering the body while thoroughly spraying the tissues and the underside of the sheet as it is being removed. Cover the entire body with a coating of Dis-Spray, and allow a few moments to dry. Then re-spray drastically affected areas such as open cancers, lesions, bedsores, eczema, wounds, etc. Pay particular attention to spraying the eyes, nose, mouth, ears, armpits, and groin.

Next, wrap cotton around the forcep, and saturate with Dis-Spray. Swab thoroughly all mucous membranes of the mouth, nostrils, and eyes. These are often the starting points for decomposition, and they are always the focal points for viewers. Dis-Spray can be used freely on these delicate areas without risk of dehydration. As with any spray product, avoid unnecessary release into the air. Spray close to the body surface and aim downward. Use with good ventilation.
